Jay Pearl (Bangor Motor Sports) 2009 NSA Points Champion

There's no doubt that Jay Pearl put up a fight in the 2009 National Speed Association (NSA) Pro Stock Asphalt Snowmobile series. The veteran racer took on the challenge and stepped up his program, winning two of the five NSA events in 2009 to claim his first NSA Points Championship.

Pearl, with the help of long time friend and tuner Kurt Thomas, had an amazing season of racing in 2009. They took their Arctic Cat 1000cc Pro Stock to the final at three events and came away with two wins and a runner up finish.

Consistency was the key for the team from Maine as they qualified in the number one spot all five points races.

The level of competition in

the NSA Pro Stock sled series is greater than any other in the country. Both rider and tuner spent many summer days testing at the

track to perfect their program and all of that hard work paid off in the end.

As the 2009 NSA Points Champion, Pearl was awarded a new MSD 7531 Digital Programmable igni-

tion from the Powersports Division at Autotronic Controls Corporation. The MSD 7531 is an incredible tuning device and has become

quite popular in the NSA Pro Stock Sled ranks. It allows the tuner to program a specific timing curve before each run and has download capabilities allowing the tuner to see the entire run after the pass is made.

Wahl Bros Racing Asphalt Challenge

2009 was the second year of the Wahl Bros. Racing Asphalt Challenge series. This 3-race points series was masterminded by Dave Wahl, owner of Wahl Bros Racing Products. Wahl, who has been racing snowmobiles for decades, has built one of the most successful snowmobile performance parts companies in the country.

The Wahl Asphalt Challenge series is a separate, three-race points series within the NSA Championship Points program. The 2009 Wahl Asphalt Challenge was comprised of three NSA events - June 13, August 8 and September 13, all of which were hosted by New England Dragway in Epping, New Hampshire.

Dan Meyer (Gray, ME) took the early lead in the Wahl Challenge with his event win in June on the Meyer Racing Pro Stock Ski-doo. With his runner up finish, Scott Marsh (Highland, NY) would closely follow Meyer heading into the second Wahl Challenge event.

The results from the second Wahl event shook up the points as Meyer ended up tied for first place with Jay Pearl (Newport, ME) after his number one qualifying spot and event win. To add to the excitement, only 2 points separated third and fourth place after round two, with Ken Lund (Brunswick, ME) in third with 161 points and Marsh in fourth with 159 points.

The Wahl Challenge points battle came down to the third and final race last season with both Pearl and Meyer in contention for the series win. Meyer unfortunately had a carburetor issue in the first round of the final event which gave the Wahl Title to Pearl. Both Pearl and Meyer had tremendous success in the Wahl Asphalt series, each with a series event win and a runner up finish.

Qualifying at the last event was the determining factor for the second and third place battle as well. Marsh was right on the heels of Meyer for the second place spot with his event win, but Meyer out-qualified Marsh by just a few spots, allowing him to keep second place in the final points.

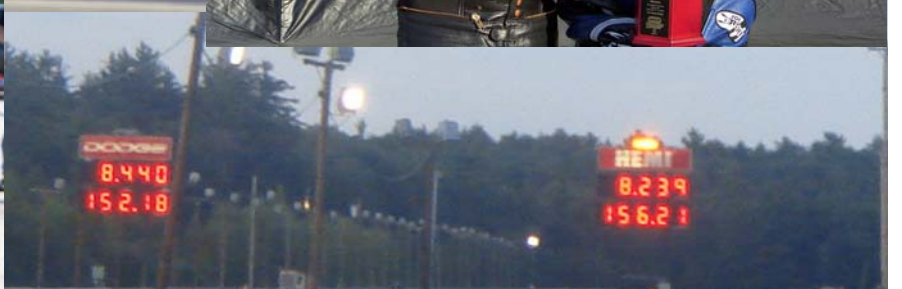

During the off season, Pearl decided to make some changes to his program. He had Phil Stanley of PCS Performance build a new lightweight chromoly tube front end and new custom pipes for his MRE 1000cc motor. The team added a new, lightweight hood and came out swinging with a beautiful new stars and stripes paint job.

Pearl began racing snowmobiles in the late 90's. Like most enthusiasts, he started with lake racing and local radar runs, which is where he and Thomas originally met. Pearl moved into asphalt racing in 2000 at the local 1/8th mile tracks. The natural progression into 1/4 mile drag racing followed with a trip around the country racing the NHRA circuit in 2004, ending at the NHRA National event in Brainerd, MN.

Pearl began racing in the NSA series in 2005 when it began. "We wanted to race against the best and we found that with the NSA series", said Pearl. "At any given event there are a large number of teams that can contest for a win which forces us to remain focused." Pearl enjoys the family atmosphere also. "It is unique in the racing world to find a group who gathers together with their competitors and families the way we do in the NSA."

Jay Pearl, rider of the #77 Bangor Motorsports Pro Stock, is a Partner and Financial Advisor at Financial Benefit Services Corporation. He lives in Newport,



Maine with his wife Darcy and his son Carter. Pearl and Thomas plan on another summer of continued testing in 2010. "We have a number of things we are anxious to work on", said Pearl. "We want to build on our 2009 performance while not sacrificing our consistency. End goal is always to win races!"

New England Dragway and NSA create strong alliance in 2010

New England Dragway (NED), located in Epping, New Hampshire will host the National Speed Association's (NSA) Pro Stock 1000cc sled events for fifth season in 2010, including the IHRA North American Nitro Jam.

When the NSA series officially kicked off in 2005, one of the many goals written into the business plan was to become a viable form of entertainment. After five seasons of proven performance, the NSA series has evolved into one of the premiere groups to race at NED.

"Pro Stock snowmobile competitors truly reflect the basic tenets of drag racing", said Joe Lombardo, Track Manager of NED. "The sport (of drag racing) is known as a venue for those with ingenuity and talent to wring out the last drop of performance from their respective machines. Given the platform snowmobile competitors have to work with it's truly amazing to see how far they've come" added Lombardo. "It's also a kick to watch the expression on a fan's face when the scoreboard lights up at the end of a spectacular run."

The NSA Pro Stock sled series will compete five times at New England Dragway, starting on May 22 with the NSA season opener. NSA will race during the popular Funny Cars Under the Stars event on June 12, Night of Fire event on July 17 and Jet Cars Under the Stars event on August 7. The NSA tour will contest its final points event of the season at the IHRA North American Nitro Jam event in September, the track's major meet of the season.

Lombardo is enthusiastic about the return of the NSA Pro Stock Sled series this season. So enthusiastic in fact, that he's created a purse for the series. NED will be paying \$650 to the NSA event winner and \$350 to the runner up at each major event in 2010. "NSA is starting to develop a following at our major events" said Lombardo. "People enjoy the class and it's becoming part of our major event program." The veteran track manager believes in providing an incentive during these events to reward the NSA group for helping the track grow.

This is the first time in the history of Pro Stock Asphalt Snowmobile racing that a venue has acknowledged the strength of the 'fast sleds' by offering a payout. Another major step forward in Pro Stock asphalt racing.



"The NSA series has emerged as one of the most organized groups to run at New England Dragway" noted Lombardo. "Simply put, it's a pleasure to work with them."
